All rain barrels are reused 55 gallon plastic food shipping barrels. Barrels come standard with hose spigot, screened lid for easy water intake and a standard hose overflow attachment. Since the barrels are recycled there may be some scratches or dents but this will not affect their functionality.

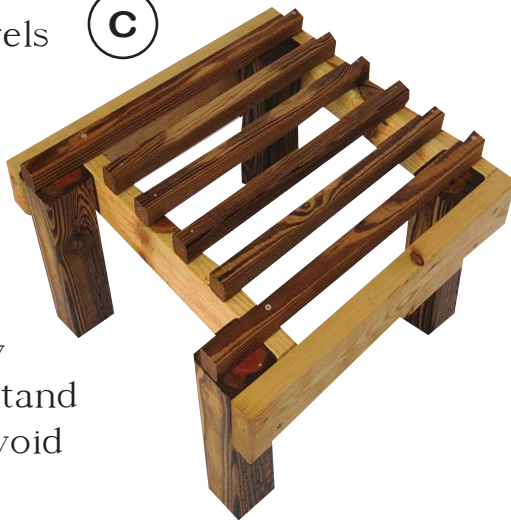
Winter preparation will require draining the rain barrel. Do not let it freeze with water in it.

Stand

Single stands for the rain barrels are handmade from treated lumber and are very durable. Stands allow the barrels to be securely elevated to ensure easy collection of water from the spigot. A full barrel can weigh 450 pounds so it is very important to ensure that the stand is placed on level ground to avoid a hazardous situation.

Downspout Diverters

Diverters are ideal for collecting rain water into rain barrels. The diverters allow you to manually direct the flow of water into the barrel.

Diverters are available for 2x3 or 3x4 inch downspouts. They are available in white and brown, with other colors available via special order.

Y Diverter

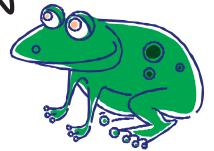
